**RULES:**

**Stock: 3 MPH - unaltered tires only 18" max hitch height**

3200, 3700, 4200, 4700 - 13.6x38 max 5200, 5700, 6200, 6700, 7700 - 15.5x38/16.9x34 max 8700, 9700 - 18.4x38 max

**Modified: 4 MPH - any cut tires 20" max hitch height**

3700, 4200, 4700, 5200, 5700 - 15.5x38/16.9x34 max 6200, 6700, 7700, 8700, 9700 - 18.4x38 max

**Modified: 6 MPH - any cut tires 20" max hitch height**

3700, 4200, 4700, 5200, 5700, 6200, 6700, 7700, 8700, 9700 - 18.4x38 max

**Jackpot Classes: 3850 (3mph), 5350 (4mph), 6350 (6mph)**

All 3 divisions - \$40 entry fee 1st Jackpot per Tractor 1st place pay back only

**\*\*minimum of a 3 inch hole with a minimum of 3/4 of an inch material on the back side of hitch hole\*\***

**SATURDAY CLASSES**

3MPH - \$20 HOOK FEE - 3200, 3700, 4200, 4700, 5200, 5700, 6200, 6700, 7700, 8700, 9700

4MPH - \$25 HOOK FEE - 3700, 4200, 4700, 5200, 5700, 6200, 6700, 7700, 8700, 9700

**PAYOUTS**

75% payout back to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd pullers for all classes 50% of pot to 1st for jackpot classes.

**GENERAL RULES**

For insurance purposes, all pullers must be members of the NYSEA. Memberships can be purchased the day of the pull at \$15 for single and \$25 for family. Wheelie Bars are MANDATORY. 18" minimum from rear axle centerline to hitch Drivers less than 16 years of age must have written parental/guardian permission. Signups: Best to sign up early. When the current classes start pulling, on both sleds, the following classes are officially closed. If you miss your pull, you cannot pull later in the class.

 Hitch Height: 20" max, 18" min. back from center of rear axle.

4350 LBS

4MPH

Tire Size: 15.5 x 38 or 16.9 x 34 and under

**Large Tire Bracket**

Tires: Any Cut  
 Hitch Height: 20" max, 18" min. back from center of rear axle.

5750 LBS

5mph

Tire Size: 18.4 x 38 MAX

**\*\*Minimum of a 3" hole with a minimum of 3/4" of material on the back side of hitch hole. Also, rules for small tire cut and big tire cut are the same as our normal class rules.\*\***
